


# Do I Need a Pass?

**You need a pass if you leave your car unattended at a Red Rock fee site. Display a valid pass or decal on your dashboard.**

## Where Can I Get a Valid Pass?

**Red Rock Passes:** Daily and Weekly Passes are available from fee machines at all fee sites (debit and credit cards only). Annual Passes are available at the Red Rock Ranger Station. Passes are available also at the Chamber of Commerce, Oak Creek Visitor Center, and local vendors.


